

Important Information - You must read the following to interpret your results:-

If your Overall Result is Pass	(1) If you are not a final year student you need to register for the next stage of your course. See the section <i>Registration for Continuing Students</i> below for details. (2) If you are a final year student (level 6 or 7) and have applied via Advanced Entry, you will be contacted before 25 th September should you be eligible for an offer. (3) If you are a Final Year student WIT will be in touch with details of graduation.
If your Overall Result indicates Allowed To Progress	You have been permitted to progress to the next year of your course without having passed all modules. You need to register for the next stage of your course. During the online registration process you will be provided with the list of the modules you are carrying. If your Overall Result is not a Pass and you are not allowed to progress	You must register as a Repeat Learner
